Superior Essex Communications is committed to keeping our employees and their families, customers, business partners and friends safe in these uncertain times. As we try to best manage the situation with COVID – 19, we will use information and recommendations provided by the Center for Disease Control, the World Health Organization and other global government agencies as the basis for our actions.

We have instituted the following:

- Postponed all international travel until further notice and limiting domestic travel.
- For all of our protection, we have put into place limitations on visitors to all of our locations.
- We have asked each Superior Essex individual to practice social distancing, which includes:

  - No handshaking, hugs or other close contact.

- And as a continued reminder, all of us need to practice good disease prevention etiquette, which is critical in preventing the spread of most illnesses, which includes:
  - Frequent hand washing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use of an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60-95% alcohol.
  - Sneezing/coughing into a tissue or your elbow.
  - Avoiding interaction with people who are obviously sick.
  - Avoiding touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.
